POSTER ENTRY GUIDELINES:

1. The posters must be created on white 12-inch by 18-inch paper available at the Harwinton Library.
2. Media such as poster tempera, crayon, felt tip markers, watercolors, or pen and ink may be used to create your design in color or black and white.
3. The theme title, “THE JOY OF READING” must be included in your design. Additional phrases or words should be kept to a minimum. If added, words must be spelled correctly and be readable from a distance.
4. Posters must be the student’s original artwork and lettering.
5. All posters must be done by an individual. Joint artwork is not permitted.
6. The winner must sign a release statement for reproduction.
7. The winner must sign a statement that the idea, concept, and artwork are all original and is free of corrections, overdrawing or outlining by someone else.
8. The winner’s poster will be reproduced and used on the Harwinton Library Friends tote bags to be sold at our fundraising events.

**The student’s name, age, and grade
along with the guardian’s name and phone number
must be included on the back of each poster that is submitted.**

The criteria for judging will include:

1. Interpretation of the Theme
2. Originality
3. Level of Creativity
4. Color Harmony
5. Neatness of Artwork
6. Artistic Skill
